***Britton-Macon Area School
PTO Scholarship Requirements***

General Instructions:

1. Scholarship applications must be typed, signed, and dated to be eligible for consideration.
2. Transcripts are required from 9th grade up to the due date of the application.
3. The applicant shall prepare an essay which includes the following:
 - a. Explain why you are a good choice for this scholarship.
 - b. Describe your involvement, with our young students, in school and community activities as well as PTO sponsored events (Preference may be given to those involved with PTO).
 - c. Explain how your involvement in youth activities has impacted you as an individual as well as the children you have worked with.
 - d. State your plans for future education at an accredited College, University, or Trade School. Please indicate the direction of study you wish to pursue.
4. A letter of recommendation is requested from a faculty member or administrator from the school. The recommendation should address the applicant's character and involvement in school activities. Recommendations must be dated and signed.
5. A letter of recommendation is requested from a responsible community member. This person must not be related to the applicant. The community member must have direct knowledge of the applicant's participation as a volunteer, in work service, church activities, or other community involvement. Recommendations must be dated and signed.

I understand that this scholarship, if granted to me, is for pursuing a course of study at a College, University, or Trade School. If for any reason my plans change before beginning my pursuit of further education, I will inform the PTO by letter. At that time, the PTO will have the right to re-evaluate my application and revoke my scholarship.

I also understand that failure to notify the PTO of any change in my education plans will result in automatic revocation of any scholarship that I might have otherwise received from the PTO.
