Tips for a winning scholarship application:

- ~ **Be yourself** . When filling out scholarship application forms, be complete, concise and creative. The judges want to know the real you.
- ~ **Complete the application in full** . Do not leave a question blank. If you're not sure a question applies, make a note on the application - just don't leave any questions blank.
- ~ **Neatness counts** . Proofread the entire application carefully for misspelled words or grammatical errors. Ask a friend, teacher or parent to proofread it as well.
- ~ **Watch all deadlines** . To help keep yourself on track, make your own deadline at least two weeks before the official deadline. Use the extra time to make sure everything is ready on time.
